

## #SmokefreeShreveport

On August 1, 2021 Shreveport City Council enacted a smoke-free ordinance for its bars and gaming establishments. At the time, there were concerns the gaming industry would suffer as a result. However, time has shown casino revenue has been largely unaffected AND workers and patrons have no longer been exposed to the cancer-causing toxins found in secondhand smoke.







Shreveport's smoke-free casinos have followed the same trends as casinos in neighboring Bossier City.



During Aug. '21, ALL casinos experienced a decrease in revenue.



When combined, Shreveport's two casinos had more annual revenue than three out five casinos in Bossier City.



Shreveport casinos will benefit from decreased employee sick time and turnover.



All Shreveport-Bossier casinos (except Margaritaville) had a lower revenue 2022/post-Covid compared to 2019/Pre-Covid.\*



The gaming industry is rebounding from the effects of Covid-19. In March 2023, revenue was up 230% compared to the same time last year.

\*No casinos have reached pre-Covid revenues.
